

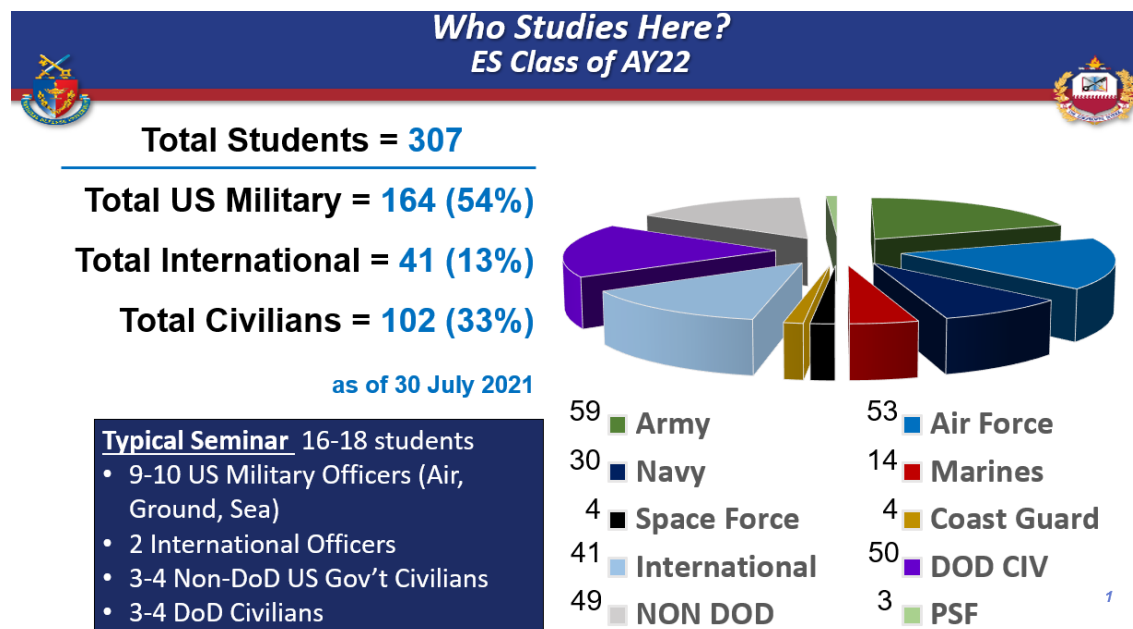
New Students
